Fairweather is committed to delivering safe and secure accommodation to vulnerable people living within our houses. We do not tolerate any forms of abuse, violence or oppression.

If you are worried and suspect that someone you know is in danger from abuse then you can speak to a worker in confidence.

## Abuse can take many forms...

**Physical:** such as shaking, pushing, hitting, force-feeding, tying up or locking someone up.

**Sexual:** such as unwanted touching, incest, rape or buggery.

**Neglect :** such as leaving someone alone for inappropriate periods of time, failing to care for them.

**Financial:** such as holding money back, cheating or stealing money.

**Psychological:** such as rejecting, ignoring, humiliating or intimidating someone.

**Discriminatory:** such as treating someone unfairly due to their skin colour, religion, sex, disability or sexual orientation.

## Who Does It?

Sadly, it is anyone, including one's nearest and dearest, a worker or someone that you know in a professional capacity. There is no specific type of person that could be responsible for abusing adults. Therefore, if you suspect anything or anyone you should help to break the silence by speaking out.

## Where Is It?

Abuse can happen anywhere, for instance –

- in a person's home,
- in the street,
- in a residential setting,
- in a day centre
- in a resource centre,
- in a hospital

## What Can I Do?

The abuse to adults can stop if we all work together. Tell a worker and you will be listened to and supported. If you feel unable to speak to a worker at the house then you can always contact the Service Manager who will deal with the matter calmly, sensitively and in a confidential manner.

Fairweather will investigate any allegations using Bradford's "No Secrets Policy". All investigations will be carried out in a way that protects your identity and does not expose you to anything and anyone.
